The Tobacco and Marijuana Prevention Toolkits are theory-based and evidence-informed curricula created by educators, parents, and researchers aimed at preventing middle and high school students' use of tobacco/nicotine, and marijuana. Goals of the Toolkit

- Students understand the harms and risks associated with tobacco and marijuana products such as electronic cigarettes, JUULs, & other vape pens.
